NEW SERVICE TRIP!! PCSC has a tradition of summer service trips, but for the upcoming April 2026 break, Ken is hoping to organize a trip to Willow Witt Ranch, in Medford, Oregon. Willow Ranch is a working organic farm with beautiful hiking trails and animals. They are affiliated with The Crest Outdoor School which uses the site to provide educational programs for elementary school kids from all over Oregon.



Help build wood sheds to store firewood for future paying visitors, work in their barn and animals, and maintain their grounds. We may also go into Medford to cook a meal for 100 people in greater need.

We will stay in tent cabins warmed by wood burning stoves. We plan to cook our own meals and eat together. In addition, we will spend one day visiting other nature areas, hiking local trails, and touring nearby communities like Ashland.
